Philosophical conceptualisation of the education system in China.

Abstract.

The aim of this article is to examine the characteristics of the education system in China from an historical perspective and how this has affected Chinese society.

This is a topical issue and by identifying the major socio-cultural influences will help successful planning and development of the modernization of the Chinese higher education system. The aims of rearing and educating children are subject to change as philosophy, pyscho-padagogical theories and society's demands change.
